Lost or Destroyed Certificate Affidavit

1. This affidavit must be *signed* and completed by the recorded owner.
2. Please print or type required information.
3. Please enclose at least two color photographs showing all markings (photos must be no smaller than 3x3 inches with the horse being 80% of the picture). One photo must be from left side and the other from the right, with the horses head turned toward the camera, with the forelock pulled aside so that the entire face is clearly visible. Additional close-up photos showing any white markings is suggested.
4. Return this form, photographs and a duplication fee of \$20.00 for Members or \$40.00 for Non-Members to the CHSA Registry.
5. Hair sample may be required for DNA verification if ownership has been transferred. Fee is \$35.00 : the DNA form and instructions are supplied by the CHSA Registrar.

I also understand that any false statements furnished to the CHSA as a basis for any action by the CHSA with respect to any horse is a violation of Rule 139 of the Rules and Regulations and would likely subject me to the penalties under the Disciplinary Procedures of the CHSA.
